

Can you help think of the first sound in each word?</p>
<u>Phonics</u>	<p>This week we would like to focus on the initial sounds in words.</p> <p>Ask a grown up to write down a list of the things you find each day. Can you recognise any letters from your own name?</p>	<p>What letter does your name start with? Can you think of any other words that start with this sound? Can you find something yellow that starts with the letter b? Can you find something that moves that starts with the letter c?</p> <p>Have a go at writing these letters in the air.</p>	<p>Name an animal that starts with the letter t. Find 2 of the same thing that start with the letter s. Find something that starts with the letter d.</p> <p>Have a go at writing these letters with a crayon.</p>	<p>Name a fruit that starts with a g. Find something you wear that starts with the letter h. Find something blue that starts with a p. Name a place you can go that starts with a z.</p> <p>Have a go at writing these letters with your favourite colour pen.</p>
