




Watch the 't' song on youtube and practice saying the t correctly. Make a t poster to put up on your fridge, every time you see this letter on your poster say the sound correctly.



To help write the letter correctly we say, 'Down the tower, cross the tower' Practice writing the letter t on some paper, make sure you start at the top of the letter every time you write it.



Build some towers with blocks, every time you place another block on top say the 't' sound correctly. Write the letter t on post it notes and place one note on to each block of your tower.

Practical ideas

Here are some practical learning ideas you could try. Some of them could be linked to our topic, but some of them might be linked to other areas of learning.



Make your own game of skittles, write the numbers 1-10 on each bottles and roll a ball into the skittles. Keep a score of how well you do! Can you knock down all tem of your pins?

Hot/cold game



*Something is hidden in the room.
Your grown up helps you find it by saying "you're getting hot" if you're close. "You're getting cold" if you're not close*

Hide an object in your house and then ask someone to find it. If they get close to the hidden object then you can say 'you're getting hot'



Make a pasta chain for a necklace or bracelet. Thread the penne pasta through some string and colour each pasta piece in a different colour to make it bright and colourful!
