




This week our focus will be about 'My time in Reception'.


We would love you to complete the activities this week and take a photo to send in, so that we can send them to your new year 1 teacher. They would love to get to know you more.



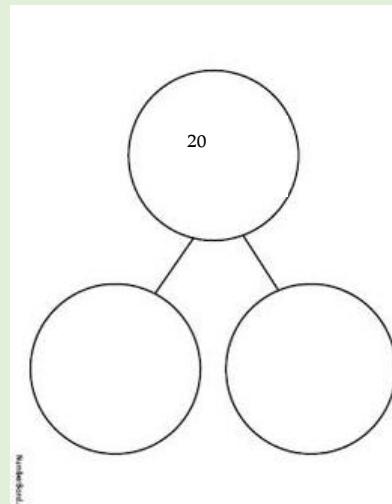

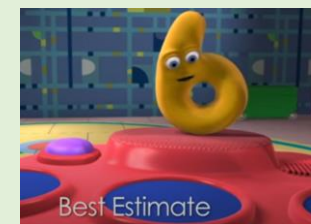
Then have play and write down all the ways you can make it in your red books.
