This is the first part of our work in division. When we share in division we make sure it is equal.</p> <p>Paul has 8 objects. He shares them between 2 friends. How many would each friend have? We can solve this by sharing objects into 2 circles (you can draw the circle on a piece of paper and use any objects you have at home to share between the circles)!</p> <p>Answer:</p> <p>Paul has 8 objects and now shares them between 4 friends. How many would each friend have? We can solve this by sharing objects into 4 circles.</p> <p>Answer:</p> <p>Hanifa has 20 objects and shares them between 5 friends. How many would each friend have?
