

<b>Extract</b>	Hermione was running toward them down the path, Hagrid puffing along behind her.	
<b>Inference pg.205</b>	What does this extract tell you about Hagrid?	2
<b>ANSWER Miss Rea's example answer</b>	<b>I think</b> Hagrid is very unfit <b>because it says</b> he was puffing along behind her, <b>which tells me</b> he was out of breath and couldn't keep up with hormone even though he has very long legs.

<b>Extract</b>	<p><i>Harry had taken one step toward it when a <b>slithering</b> sound made him freeze where he stood. A bush on the edge of the clearing quivered.... Then, out of the shadows, a hooded figure came <b>crawling</b> across the ground <b>like some stalking beast</b>. Harry, Malfoy, and Fang stood transfixed. The cloaked figure reached the unicorn, lowered its head over the wound in the animal's side, and <b>began to drink its blood</b>.</i></p>	
<b>Inference</b> pg. 205	<p>What animal does J.K.Rowling make the figure sound like? Use evidence from the text to help you (the purple words might give you a clue).</p>	3

<b>Extract</b>	<p><i>The centaur didn't answer. He had astonishingly blue eyes, like pale sapphires. He looked carefully at Harry, his eyes lingering on the scar that stood out, <b>livid</b>, on Harry's forehead.</i></p>
