We will use this topic to learn about different forms of transport, on the land, sea and air. We will explore building transport and making models.

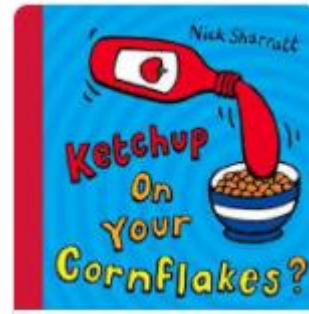


We will also be celebrating father's day this term.
