During the Summer Term we will be focusing on a number of different fiction and non-fiction texts all around our termly themes of Knights and Castles and Game Over.

We will be working with the children on their grammar, spelling and punctuation and placing an increased emphasis on reading comprehension.

Children will be supported by extra reading with adults in school and taking part in reading interventions, however we would like to emphasise that it is very important that your child is read with at home at least 4x a week to ensure they continue to progress and this is recorded in their reading diaries.

In writing, we will be exploring different writing formats including descriptive writing, recounts, diary entries, setting descriptions and re-telling stories.

We are now carrying out homework through Microsoft Teams. It is set every Friday and due in the following Wednesday. This is related to what we are doing in school and the focus in Summer Term 1 will be mathematic. Please ensure your child carries out this homework.

- **What was the story about?**
- **Who were the main characters?**
- **What happened at the end of the story?**
- **Was the text fiction or non-fiction?**
- **If it was non-fiction can you show me how you use an index page/content page or glossary?**
- **What happened on page 7?**
- **What was your favourite part of the text/story?**
- **Any other general questions relating to the text**
