## Homework

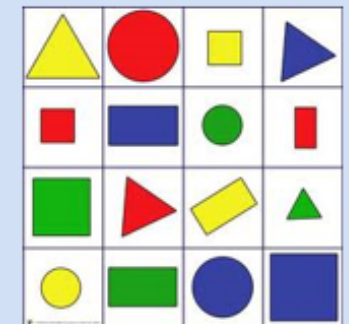
Each week, we will be uploading a piece of homework to Microsoft TEAMS, along with a short teaching video to provide explanation for what children need to do.

# Maths

Children have a daily Maths lesson. We will link as much of our Maths to our Connected Curriculum topic 'The Ancient Egyptians' as we can. Our work this term will centre on the topics of fractions, decimals, money and time. Children will be comparing and ordering decimals to two decimal places! .



Our work on calculation methods will also continue, so ask your child to explain these to you!

We are continuing to work on children's times tables. Children are being asked out of order facts as well as division facts to move onto learning the next x table.

# History

This term, our history work is revolving around our new topic of the Ancient Egyptians. Within these lessons children will be answering the questions:
