### Reading Books



Children will be taking 2 books home soon as the Little Wandle Phonics programme progresses. One book will be a read together book which is for you to read with your child. The other book your child will take home will have been read several times in class. So the children will have more confidence in reading this independently. This will be in several weeks' time.

Please can we ensure that each time you read with your child you comment and sign in their Reading Diaries. It is important that the books are returned back to school each week. If any books are lost or damaged, there is a £5 charge.

**Please feel free to come and talk to us about your child's reading at any time. You can really help by building their comprehension skills by asking questions about the book.**

### Topic

Our topic for **Autumn 1** is **Dream Big**. We will be learning about a variety of people who help us and as we become more familiar with the children we will begin to follow their interests.

Our topic for **Autumn 2** will be **'I am Special'**. We will be finding out all about ourselves and how we are special. We will also be learning about the different types of celebrations and the people who celebrate them, such as Halloween, Christmas and Diwali.

Work will be set on a Friday and be returned back on the following Thursday. This is all online. Each Friday we will be sending out a recap of the phonics sounds and words, so that you can practice at home with your child.
