We will be exploring fractions, including addition and subtraction of fractions, as well as working between mixed numbers and improper fractions. We will then move on to multiplication and division using written methods.

We will use all our skills to solve a variety of problems.

English

We have an English lesson every day. This term we are focusing on linking our work as much as possible to our 'Earth in Space' topic. Children will be using their imagination and creativity to write a non-chronological report about a creature that lives on the planet of Pandora from a film clip based on "Avatar" on another planet. They will also be writing a story based on the planet of Pandora. Children will also be writing a newspaper article in order to report a rover landing on the moon. They will be learning lots of new skills to include in their writing. We will also be focussing on vocabulary carefully in order for it to have an effect on the reader. We will be reading lots of texts linked to our writing.
